SunDial is an improved turf-type tall fescue (*Festuca arundinacea*), providing superior density, dark color, and finer leaf texture. **SunDial** has wide adaptation and has performed well in National tests across several states. It is an excellent choice for use on home lawns, parks, athletic fields, golf course roughs or out-of-play areas and community green spaces.



DROUGHT TOLERANT

Pest and Disease Resistance: **SunDial** shows good performance under disease pressure from brown patch, pythium and net blotch. Seedstock of **SunDial** has an endophyte content that provides resistance to many surface-feeding insects.

Traffic Tolerance: In a traffic study, there was no statistical difference between **SunDial** and the #1 entry in genetic color, percent brown patch, percent pythium, quality, quality after traffic of 10 games, quality after traffic of 20 games, quality 2 weeks after traffic stopped, quality 2 months after traffic stopped, percent cover, percent cover after 10 games, and percent cover 2 weeks after traffic, percent cover 1 month after traffic, fall color retention after 10 games, fall color retention 2 weeks after traffic stopped and fall color retention 1 month after traffic stopped. **SunDial** was comparable to the best entries in scientific measurements of both soil moisture and surface softness.

Adaptation: **SunDial** is widely adaptable to management regimes including high, medium and low; including cutting heights of 1 to 3 inches (2.5-7.5 cm), with best performance at 2" (5 cm).

Blends Well: **SunDial** is the perfect choice alone or matched with other Jacklin grasses in mixtures and blends for permanent turf in temperate and transition zone climates. For mixtures it can be seeded at 80-90% **SunDial**/10-20% Jacklin Kentucky bluegrass to improve sod strength.

SEEDING RATE: Plant at 6-10 lbs./1000 ft² (30-50 g/m²).
