**Disease Resistance:** **Answer** fights the browning caused by many common lawn diseases with its built-in pest resistance to Microdochium pink snow mold, Typhula, leaf spot, spring melting out, anthracnose, leaf rust, stem rust, dollar spot, stripe smut, anthracnose, and summer patch. With better resistance means fewer chemicals and a greener turf all year around.

**Tight Knitting for Sure-Footed Sports Turf or faster Sod Lifting:** **Answer** shows excellent tight knitting abilities for the sod producer which translates into earlier, easier lifting. For athletic fields, it translates into surer footing, with less ripping and tearing.

**Mowing Heights:** **Answer** performs very good at 1-2 in. (2.5-5 cm) mowing heights and tolerates a range of mowing heights from 0.5-3 in. (1.25-7.5 cm) and higher.

**Elite Sun-and-Shade:** **Answer** is one of the few premium bluegrasses that excels in sun or shade performance.

**Seeding Rate:** 2-3 lbs./1000 ft<sup>2</sup> (10-15 g/m<sup>2</sup>) by itself or blended with other bluegrasses. Mix **Answer** with 20% ryegrass or 80% tall fescue.
